Introducing Changes in Reporting

Target Date: January 1, 2017

Traceability

Traceability in Agriculture is based on three pillars: premises identification, product identification and movement recording. Monitoring the movement of hens ensures the protection of animal health, public health and food safety. The documents being introduced will follow the lifecycle of the hen and are crucial to tracking each point of production.

Changes to: *Replacement Layer Order Report*

Name Change: **Replacement Layer Order Report** – Formerly **Pullet Order Report**

Reporting: **The Replacement Layer Order Report must be filed with the Board at least 28 days prior to day old placement of chicks into the Pullet Grower's Facility**

Purpose – Each chick hatched for an Ontario Egg Producer must have an order form filed at the Board office.

Calculator: **Production Allotment Worksheet and Total Placement Worksheet**
Producers will now have a worksheet available to calculate the number of birds that are required at placement. Pullets may be ordered for programs but the programs must be approved by the Board prior to placement.

Tracking: **A copy of the Replacement Layer Order Report will be issued to the Egg Producer, Hatchery and Pullet Grower.**

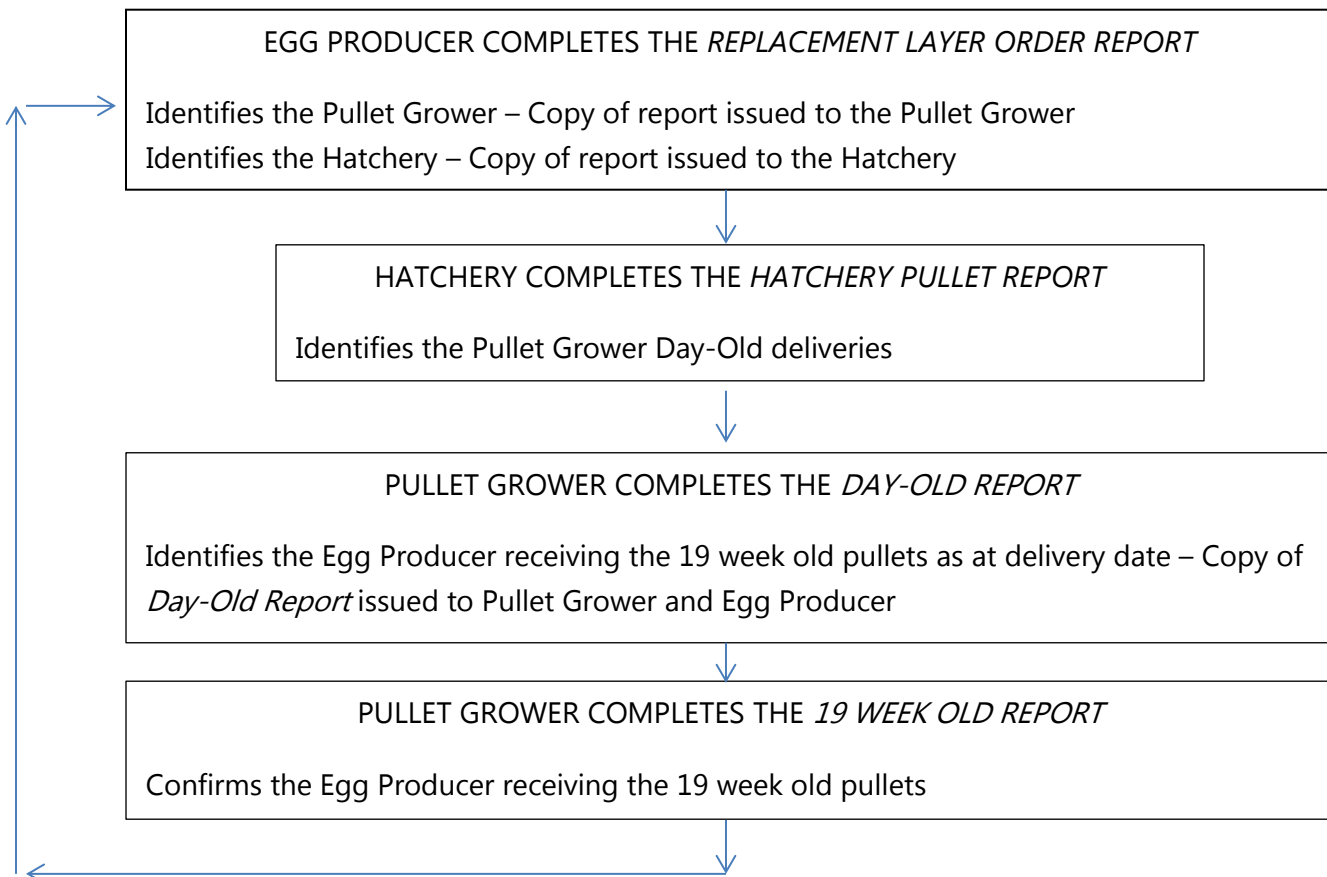
Changes to: *Pullet Grower Day-Old Report*

Additional Information: **Recipient of Pullets at 19 weeks (Egg Producer)**
 Purpose – Each chick hatched for an Ontario Egg Producer must have an intended placement at 19 weeks. This will include deliveries to Ontario Egg Producers and non-quota holders.

Tracking: **Upon receipt by the Board, all completed forms will be processed and confirmation of receipt will be issued to the Pullet Grower and Egg Producer.**

All recipients of Pullets at 19 weeks of age, including Non-Quota Holders, must be reported for all respective hatch dates.
