<b>Application Notes:</b>	
1. Home Week changes must be approved by EFO prior to any commitments being made to the Pullet Grower and Hatchery.	
2. The Board's first priority in reviewing applications is to ensure that the request does not result in a significant disruption in the "levelling of birds" across the calendar year in support of industry expectations.	
3. You are encouraged to attach a letter from your Hatchery and Grading Station to support your request. Staff will review this application as required with these stakeholders.	
4. The Board will also be concerned that the interests of the Pullet Farmer are protected.	
5. If the application is approved, in advance of that approval, staff will review with the farmer if there is any entitlement to Quota Credits.	
6. The Board does not desire to have birds lay past 52 weeks, however, on an exception basis EFO may approve an extend the lay period, for instance, if there is no reasonable evidence due to capacity that a farmer can use quota credits in the foreseeable future (five years).	
7. If an extended lay period is approved the farmer agrees to be invoiced at the end of the flock 30 cents per leviabile dozen plus HST marketed after week 52 as the cost of the pullet would have then been fully recovered.	
8. In all approved changes, Seven [7] Day Downtime requirements remain.	
9. EFO Staff will acknowledge receipt of this application through email, or by phone if the applicant is non-digital.
