# HARD-COOKED VS. BLOWN OUT

Dye the eggs first if you're going to blow them out.

## BLOWING OUT EGGS

Make sure eggs are clean!

Poke a hole in the top and bottom of the egg with a sharp object like a tooth pick or a needle, making the hole on the wide end slightly bigger.

1 TBSP VINEGAR +  
1 CUP WARM WATER +  
FOOD COLOURING

More drops = more vibrant colour

## DYEING THE EGGS

The longer you leave the egg in the dye, the more vibrant your egg will be.

Try using a brown egg to get a different colour!

## TIE-DYED EGGS

Start by dripping the lightest colours on the egg and move towards the darker colours
