
GIVING BACK TO OUR COMMUNITIES

ONE EGG AT A TIME



Ontario is home to over 500 egg and pullet farm families, with many of them farming for multiple generations. This long-term connection to regions across Ontario has led to a strong commitment to giving back to their local communities, schools, sports teams and associations.

Foodbank Donations

Since Egg Farmers of Ontario introduced the *Food Bank Egg Donation Program* in 2015, an annual donation of \$250,000 worth of eggs is distributed by Feed Ontario to its member food banks. That's about 8.5 million eggs since the start of the program! Eggs are provided through the on-going participation of graders.

Community Funding

Each year, local egg farmers contribute \$150,000 to community programs across Ontario through:

egg donations to schools from local egg farmers

Student Nutrition Programs



Egg Farmers of Ontario has worked with Student Nutrition Ontario since 2015 to help provide nutritious food to more than **1,000,000 hungry students** across Ontario. Since the beginning of this partnership, over **\$400,000** has been used to purchase eggs and the equipment needed to serve eggs in schools across Ontario.

In 2020, the partnership was extended through another three-year commitment of \$225,000.

Supporting mental health in our communities

A five-year commitment of \$150,000 was made in 2022 to support The Grove Youth Wellness Hubs in Ontario. This program provides a safe space for Ontario youth to reach out for help and support.
