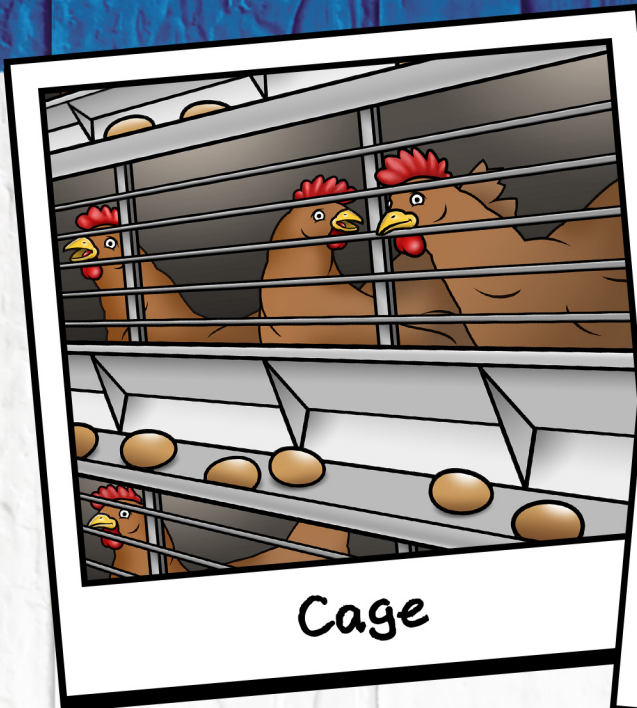
# LIFE ON AN EGG FARM

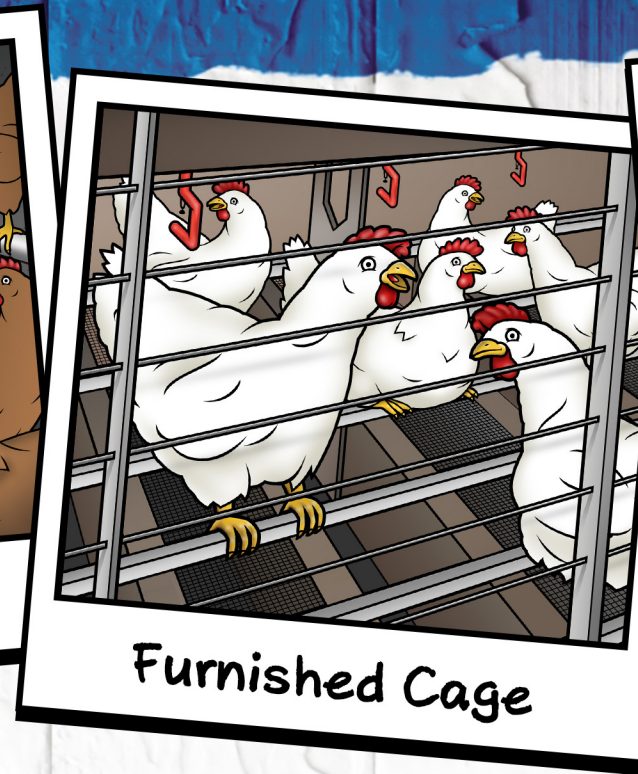

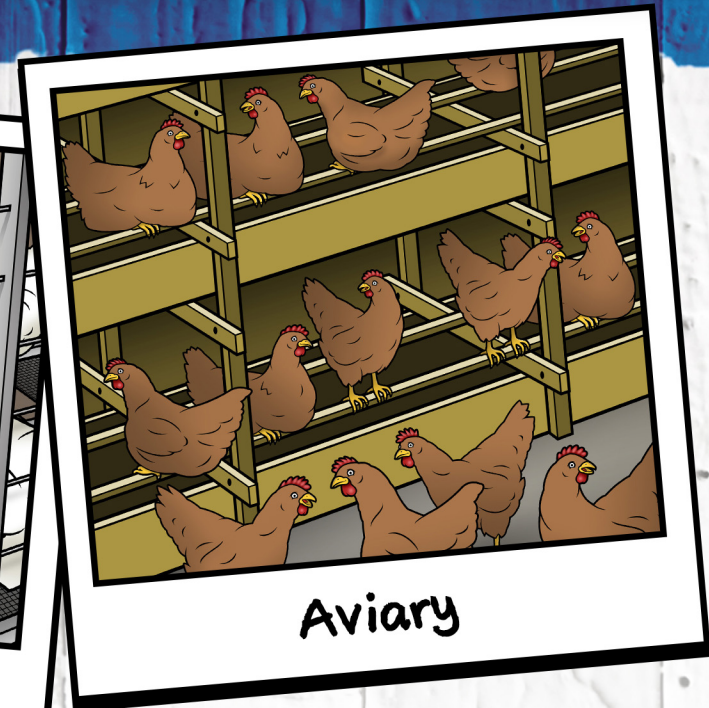

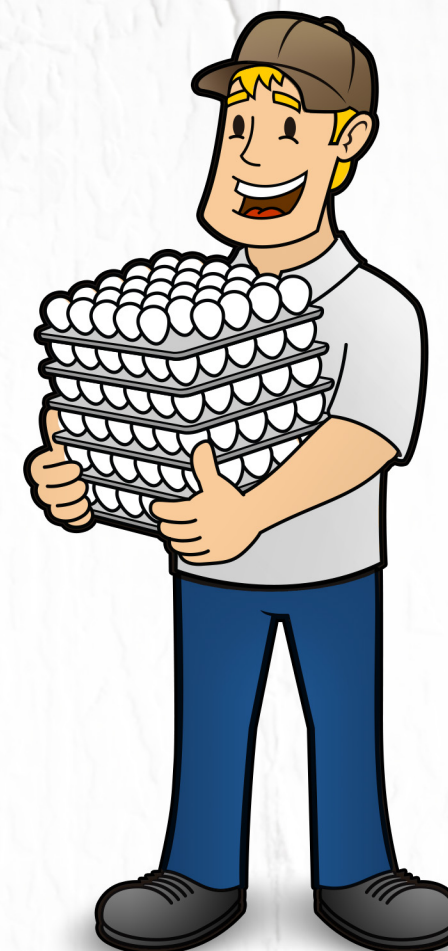
